

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 7 OF THE BOROUGH CODE, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", TO ADD ADDITIONAL PARKING SPACES RESERVED FOR PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED PERSONS ON 4<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE AND WEST LAKE AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE**

WHEREAS, Chapter 7, "Vehicles and Traffic" sets forth the regulations within the Borough of Spring Lake regarding parking and traffic within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-28 provides and authorizes locations for the placement of parking spaces reserved for physically handicapped persons pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39;4-197; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council, have determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough to authorize additional handicap spaces on 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and West Lake Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey as follows:

**Section 1.**

- a. Section 7-28, Chapter 7, of the Code of the Borough of Spring Lake entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", is hereby amended to add the following:

**§ 7-13. Parking Reserved for Physically Handicapped Persons**

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Sides</b>	<b>Location</b>
Fourth Avenue	West	Between West Lake and Mercer Avenues, first two parallel parking spaces north of ramp leading to St. Andrew's Annex
West Lake Avenue	South	First parallel parking space east of the Driveway to St. Andrew's Church

**Section 2.**

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section,

paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

**Section 3.**

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

**Section 4.**

This Ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
