

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2006-010 TO
AMEND DESCRIPTION OF PURPOSE FOR EMERGENCY
GENERATORS AUTHORIZED FOR ACQUISITION BUT NOT
INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS AND NOT AUTHORIZING
ADDITIONAL DEBT**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council adopted Bond Ordinance No. 2006-010 on June 13, 2006 and therein authorized, among other appropriations, the acquisition of an emergency generator for the First Aid Building in the amount of \$55,000; and

WHEREAS, the First Aid Building Generator has been acquired and installed and funding remains available in the appropriation; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need for an emergency generator at the Fire Company #1 Fire Station located on Fifth Avenue; which station serves as an emergency shelter and center under the Borough's Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council deem it appropriate to utilize the remaining appropriation balance from the First Aid Building Generator for the acquisition of an emergency generator for the Fire Station.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the description of purpose found and set forth in Section 3(a) of Ordinance No. 2006-010 is hereby amended and supplemented to provide as follows; with deletions reflected in strikethrough and additions reflected in **bold underline**.

Section 3.

Purpose

- a) Acquisition of a ~~generators~~ for the First Aid Building **and #1 Fire Station**, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

Section 2.

All other provisions of Ordinance No. 2006-010 not amended or replaced herein remain in full force and effect.

Section 3.

This amendment does not authorize and additional appropriation or debt.

Section 4.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

Section 5.

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

Section 6.


This Ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
