

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 7 OF THE BOROUGH CODE, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", TO CHANGE THE INTERSECTION OF WASHINGTON AND BRIGHTON FROM A YIELD TO A STOP AND TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF EAST LAKE DRIVE BETWEEN FIRST AVENUE MERCER AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE

WHEREAS, Chapter 7, "Vehicles and Traffic" sets forth the regulations within the Borough of Spring Lake regarding parking and traffic within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council, upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, have determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough to change the intersection of Brighton Avenue and Washington Avenue from a yield to a stop intersection and to prohibit parking on the north side of East Lake Avenue between First Avenue and Mercer Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1.

- a. Section 7-13, Chapter 7, of the Code of the Borough of Spring Lake entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", is hereby amended to add the following:

§ 7-13. Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets.

- b. Section 7-20, Chapter 7, of the Code of the Borough of Spring Lake entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", is hereby amended to add the following:

§ 7-20. Stop intersection.

- c. Section 7-21, Chapter 7, of the Code of the Borough of Spring Lake entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", is hereby amended to delete the following:

§ 7-21. Yield Intersection

~~Brighton Avenue and Washington Avenue~~ — ~~Washington Avenue~~

Section 2.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

Section 3.

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and


Section 4.

This Ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
