

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 180, "FIRE PREVENTION", ARTICLE II "ENFORCEMENT OF UNIFORM FIRE CODE", TO ADD SECTION 180-21(F.) AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF ALTERNATE FIRE OFFICIAL

WHEREAS, Chapter 120, "Fire Prevention", Article II "Enforcement of Uniform Fire Codes", sets forth the regulations within the Borough of Spring Lake regarding the enforcement of the Uniform Fire Code, including the procedures for the appointment of the Borough Fire Official; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council, have determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough to amend and revise those regulations to provide for the appointment of an alternate Fire Official who shall be authorized to act and perform the duties of the Fire Official in the event of the disability, unavailability or absence of the Fire Official;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1:

Section 180-21 of the Borough Code is hereby amended and supplemented by the addition of the following new subsection 180-21(F):

§ 180-21. Appointments, Term of Office, Removal

F. The Mayor and Council may appoint an Alternate Fire Official under the same terms and procedures prescribed for the appointment of the Fire Official. The Alternate Fire Official shall be authorized to act and exercise the powers and authority of the Fire Official in the event of the disability, unavailability or absence of the Fire Official.

Section 2.

All other provisions of Chapter 180 not amended or replaced herein remain in full force and effect.

Section 3.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

Section 4.

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and


Section 5.

This Ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.


