WHEREAS, the Borough of Spring Lake has undertaken various improvements to Ocean Avenue and the Arches and intends to undertake additional improvements to the retaining wall along Ocean Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Spring Lake and the County of Monmouth have agreed to jointly participate in the funding of a Safety Improvement Project on County Route 18, Ocean Avenue, in the Borough of Spring Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Funding Agreement provides for Monmouth County to reimburse the Borough of Spring Lake necessitating that the Borough authorize and appropriation of the funds to be provided by Monmouth County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, and STATE OF NEW JERSEY as follows:

SECTION 1.

The sum of four hundred five thousand two hundred fifty and 00/100 dollars (\$405,250.00) is hereby authorized and appropriated for improvements to Ocean Avenue, the Arches and the retaining wall along Ocean Avenue consistent with the Joint Funding Agreement for Safety Improvement Project on County Route 18, Ocean Avenue, in the Borough of Spring Lake.

SECTION 2.

The funding for this appropriation will be provided by the County of Monmouth pursuant to the Joint Funding Agreement.

SECTION 3.

The period of usefulness of the improvements authorized herein is in excess of the five (5) year statutory requirement.

SECTION 4.

No debt shall be incurred by the Borough for this authorization.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication as provided by law.




