



COVID19 Vaccinations – REGISTRATION INFORMATIONAS OF 2/18/21 *

*** Please note that the Borough does not distribute the vaccine, nor are we able to assist residents in getting the vaccine. The information provided above is to assist in registration for an appointment to get the vaccine.**

Many of our residents have asked us how they can get an appointment for the COVID-19 vaccine. See below for steps to follow to register for an appointment.

- 1) **STATE REGISTRATION** - Pre-register for the vaccine on the NJ Vaccine Scheduling System and you will be notified when an appointment is available to you. <https://covidvaccine.nj.gov/>
For those without internet, call 855-568-0545. Be patient as it may take some time to get through to a person.

One you are registered, you will receive an email confirming. A second email will be sent WHEN appointments become available at the state's mega sites. In that email, there will be a scheduling link and it is **up to you to schedule your appointment**. It may take numerous attempts to obtain an appointment and checking the link frequently, at different times throughout the day, will increase your chances. - 2) **MONMOUTH COUNTY REGISTRATION** - Register for the Monmouth County waitlist. <https://hipaa.jotform.com/210134615105137>
Once registered, the County Health Department will call when they have an appointment for you. The phone number will come up as a local number or as "Monmouth County Health Department".
- 3) **REGISTRATION AT DESIGNATED VACCINATION SITES** - Register directly with one or all of the designated vaccination sites across the state.

You have to be persistent on each of these sites. Once registered, bookmark them on your computer, check back regularly, resubmit the form, and refresh (repeatedly, if needed). Try the sites at different times of the day as appointments may pop up. Even when sites state that they are full, you can often still find an open appointment.
